It is hereby resolved that the draft Constitution (marked "DRAFT: 5 September 2024" and previously circulated on 5 September 2024) attached hereto be and is hereby approved and adopted as the Constitution of the Islamic Unity Society in substitution for and to the exclusion of the existing Constitution of the Islamic Unity Society and that the Trustees of the Islamic Unity Society be authorised to do all things necessary to ensure the orderly winding up of the Islamic Unity Society.

Note: As explained in the notice circulated on 5 September 2024, the proposed amendments are aimed at streamlining the Constitution with a simpler and achievable dissolution process, which will allow the IUS to close in a clean, legal, and orderly manner.
